**Date & Time: Wednesday, April 24, 2024**

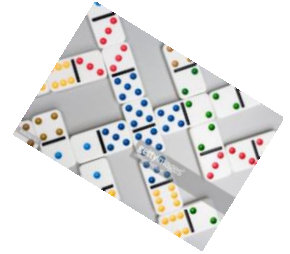
- **10:00 am** – Registration; "Meet & Greet" w/Cash Bar
