Community Contribution Award requests must be submitted by **April 16, 2027**, by a BCCWC member. BCCWC Community Contribution Awards are only given out once at the end of each fiscal year. The BCCWC Board of Directors will vote on requests at the June board meeting.

Community Awards will be considered for organizations that:

- are located in Brown County.
- are classified as a 501(c)(3) non-profit and have a federal EIN.
- do not promote a specific religion or a political agenda.
- do not benefit a member.
- do not benefit from school fundraising activities.

Keep the BCCWC mission statement in mind. Request Community Awards for programs that:

- provide charitable, educational or cultural services, or
- improve the quality of life for local residents, or
- cultivate an appreciation of art, music and other cultural resources, or
- focus on physical and mental wellness.

All programs submitted must be available to residents of Brown County.
